STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATION: I, _____,

am a certified (check one) [] SCUBA INSTRUCTOR, [] ASSISTANT SCUBA INSTRUCTOR,
[] DIVEMASTER, [] ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER, and I am authorized by my military or
public safety agency to lead scuba diving training activities at LAKE RAWLINGS.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: We plan to use LAKE RAWLINGS from _____

WITNESS the following conditions to use LAKE RAWLINGS:

1. I certify that the Training Director meets the standards of my agency to lead scuba training at LAKE RAWLINGS.
2. My agency agrees to pay an annual fee of FIVE-HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for the privilege to conduct scuba and other in-water training at LAKE RAWLINGS on weekdays from Monday through Friday during the peak and slack seasons. Training can be conducted everyday during the off-season.
3. I agree to abide by the policies of my agency and that of LAKE RAWLINGS when leading activities involving in-water training of my agency's military or public safety personnel.
4. I agree all scuba and other in-water activities at LAKE RAWLINGS must remain exclusively in the control of those personnel from my military or public safety agency. I also agree that

personnel participating in scuba training at LAKE RAWLINGS are all certified divers. There is no limit to the number of participants so long as they meet the standards of my military or public safety agency.

- 5. I agree to hold harmless LAKE RAWLINGS and its agents for all activities for which my military or public safety agency is responsible.
- 6. I have received and submitted a signed LAKE RAWLINGS waiver and release agreement from every diver or participant in my group.
- 7. I agree to inform everyone in my group that: (a) the consumption of alcoholic beverages, to include beer and wine, is strictly prohibited at the lake and surrounding land at all times; (b) all illegal drugs and related paraphernalia will be strictly prohibited from the lake and surrounding land at all times; and (c) all displays of firearms and/or fireworks, and its use, will be strictly prohibited from the lake and surrounding land at all times.
- 8. This AGREEMENT becomes null and void one year after the execution date, and it is renewable at any time.

LAKE RAWLINGS PROCEDURES FOR ANNUAL CONTRACT

- 1. Completely fill-out contract, Two copies are needed date these for one year, sign and return original inside the SA/SS envelope.**

- 2. Each member of the dive team must complete an individual waiver/assumption of risk agreement, date it through December 31st, and submit to the Lake Rawlings staff on the first visit. This agreement is to be filled out annually by each participating diver. These forms can be downloaded from our web site at www.lakerawlings.com. Copies may be duplicated.**

- 3. The Group Manifest is completed on each visit and submitted to the attendant on duty. Copies may be duplicated.**

- 4. Our policy allows for law enforcement or military dive units to train at Lake Rawlings on any Monday through Friday year round. The annual fee is \$500.00, and there are no restrictions on the number of participants from your unit. Unit is defined as lowest element with a commander. This fee does not include other services such as air fills or camping.**

- 5. Your unit must follow the same general rules reserved for civilian divers (see inside the enclosed brochure).**

- 6. Gas motorized watercraft are not allowed during training exercises; however, a safety chase boat at the water's edge is permitted when training on the lake.**

- 7. Access to Lake Rawlings is simple. If ever we are not open to the public, simply call 800-583-3781 or 804-478-9000. You will be met there by Lake Rawlings staff or given the combination to get in. Reservations must be confirmed at least 48-hours in advance.**

- 8. Make checks payable to LAKE RAWLINGS, and send with the enclosed contract.**

PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE TO ANYONE FOR ANY REASON.

CAMPERS - If office is open, register upon arrival. If office is closed, register, complete liability statements, and pay in the morning. RV rates are based on four adults. Fees are always due in advance.

CAMPFIRES - All campfires are confined to existing fire rings. A 5-gallon bucket with water must be ready for use. Firebuckets are available inside the Dive Shack.

CHECK OUT TIME - Check out time for RV or tent camping, day diving or swimming is 5:00 PM. Check out time for cabin camping is 2:00 PM. If you need more time check with office.

QUIET HOURS - From 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

SPEED LIMIT - Is 15 mph on driveway and 5 mph in camping and parking areas.

ALCOHOL/DRUGS - Alcohol and drugs are not permitted on the premises.

BATHHOUSE - Please help to keep our bathhouse clean at all times. Divers, please rinse your booties before entering.

SMOKING – Lake Rawlings is a No Smoking Facility.

FIREWORKS - Fireworks are not permitted to be set off in park at any time.

RV SITE - Keep your RV site clean and tidy at all times. No garbage cans or bags allowed outside your RV. Sack and tie all garbage and place inside dumpster near the lake entrance. No parking on driveway without special permission.

MESSAGES - Only emergency messages will be delivered to your site unless prior arrangements have been made with office.

CHILDREN - Parents are responsible for their child's behavior at all times. Do not leave children unsupervised in park at any time. Make sure your child understands the basic park rules.

PETS - Please advise office when registering or when making a reservation if you plan to bring a pet. No pets allowed in the staging area. Pets are restricted to the camping or parking area. No pet is to disturb others with barking. **IMPORTANT: Pick up after your pet immediately.** Pets are permitted only when registered at office and when these rules are followed. Dogs trained to attack, bite or guard are not allowed inside the park.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK - Campers, divers and swimmers will assume all responsibility for their own actions, the actions of their children and the behavior of their pets, to include personal injury, property damage or wrongful death.
