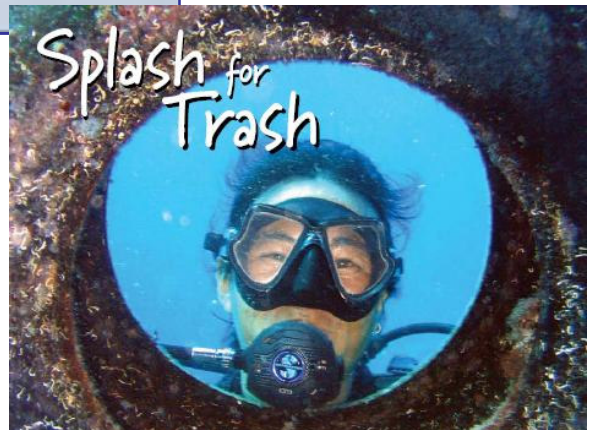




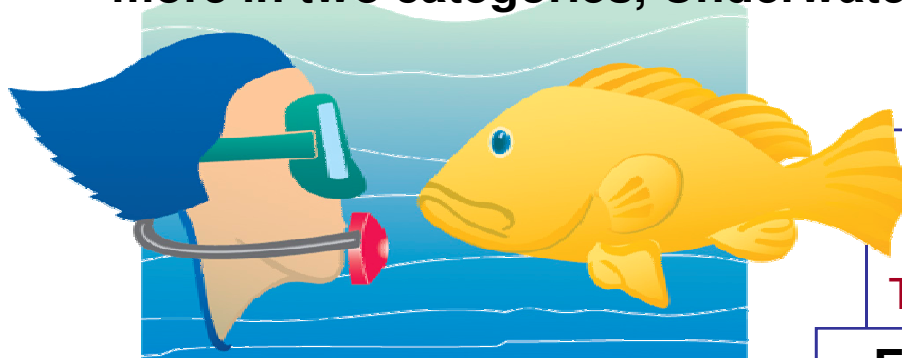

Project Aware Guidelines

1. To be in the competition, Your team should be registered by 12 noon on the day of the event.
2. Water teams are allowed to enter the water and begin their rubbish recovery anytime after 12 noon. Any area of the lake is available for rubbish recovery.
3. Please do not move or attempt to recover underwater display items. All questions about these items can be addressed to the Lake Rawlings Staff or Divemaster on duty at the dock.
4. If required use lift bags with caution for heavy items.
5. Land teams can begin their rubbish recovery anytime after 12 noon. Any area of Lake Rawlings except the lake is open to rubbish recovery including the gravel roadway from the asphalt to the dive shack.
6. Safety is your number one concern in or out of the water. Wear gloves, be cautious of sharp items. Don't continue to fill heavy trash bags, more are available as needed.
7. All teams must have all items at the dive shack for judging not later than 2pm. The decision of the judge will be final.
