Terms of Services and Conditions for Using Lake Rawlings

Scuba Instructors: All scuba instructors who teach at Lake Rawlings must meet active status requirements with their respective agency (current membership and instructor liability insurance). The instructor-student ratios for in-water activities by scuba instructors who teach at Lake Rawlings must be met according to the prevailing course standards of their respective agency. All scuba instructors will receive complimentary admission when leading a group of two or more paying divers.

Divemasters: All divemasters who supervise diving activities at Lake Rawlings must meet active status requirements with their respective agencies in terms of current membership and liability insurance. Supervision of diving activities may be direct or indirect. Divemasters will receive complimentary admission to Lake Rawlings when listed on the group manifest and there are four or more paying divers in the group.

Scuba Divers: Cost: \$20.00 per diver, and includes parking and admission. All certified divers must present their c-card to the management office to obtain admission for scuba diving. All non-certified divers must be supervised by an instructor when scuba diving at Lake Rawlings.

Law Enforcement, Military and Public Safety Trainers will not be held to the training standards of the scuba agencies. These trainers will be held to the standards of training for their law enforcement, military or public safety agency. The group leader is responsible for obtaining the lake pass and parking permit(s) for each vehicle.

Groups of 10 or More: The group leader is responsible for collecting all fees and the appropriate assumption of risk agreement from every member of the group, regardless of age or circumstance.

Seasonal & Daily Operations: Lake Rawlings will be operational daily, weekends and holidays between Memorial and Labor Day weekends. All other uses will require a 24-48 hour notice to open the premises. The lake will also be available weekends and weekdays to qualified scuba instructors, divemasters, and certified divers by calling (800) 583-3781.

Alcoholic Beverages: Beer and other alcoholic beverages, and glass containers, are strictly prohibited from the premises at all times. Violators will be told to leave the premise.

Firearms/Explosives: Firearms and explosives, including firecrackers, sparklers, etc. are strictly prohibited from the premises at all times. Violators will be prosecuted.

Trash and Garbage: Please put your trash in the provided receptacles, and diligently inform the divers and visitors in your group or class about this matter. Let's keep Lake Rawlings clean!

Lodging: If you are planning a weekend of diving activities, the Nottoway Motel & Restaurant in Rawlings is about 2.5 miles from the lake on U.S. 1, at Exit #39 of I-85. The motel telephone number is (804) 478-4421.

All divers, swimmers, campers and visitors must agree to abide by the operational rules and standards of Lake Rawlings at all times. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
